#### **TEXT of A11 of EN IEC 60335-2-11**

#### 1 Modification to the Introduction

- 17 Addition:
- 18 With European Amendment A11 the EN 60335-2-11:2010+A11:2012+A1:2015+A2:2018 is superseded.
- 19 This European Amendment A11, supplements or modifies the corresponding clauses of the standards below:
- 20 EN 60335 1:2012+A11:2014+A13:2017+A1:2019+A14:2019+A2:2019+A15:2021+A16:2021 (Part 1)
- 21 EN IEC 60335-2-11:2022 (Part 2)

#### 2 Modification to Clause "1 Scope"

Mark NOTE 102 as void.

Replace the paragraphs starting from "Appliances not intended..." up to "- children playing with the appliance" by the following:

Appliances intended to be used by laymen in shops and other premises for normal housekeeping purposes, are within the scope of this document.

NOTE Z101 Examples of appliance for household environment are appliances for typical housekeeping functions used in the household environment that may also be used by non-expert users for typical housekeeping functions:

- in shops and other similar working environments;
- in farm houses:
- by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
- in bed and breakfast type environments.

NOTE Z102 Household environments include the dwelling and its associated buildings, the garden, etc.

As far as is practicable, this document deals with the common hazards presented by appliances that are encountered by all persons in household and similar environments.

However, in general, it does not take into account

- children playing with the appliance,
- the use of the appliance by very young children,
- the use of the appliance by young children without supervision,
- 41 **user maintenance** by **children**, including the cleaning of the appliance.
- 42 It is recognized that **very vulnerable people** may have needs beyond the level addressed in this document.
- 44 Add the following dashed items to Note 104:
- 45 tumble dryers to be used in commercial areas, e.g. laundrettes (see EN 50570);
