- 31 the European Standard: Particular requirements for transportable single spindle vertical moulders.
- 32 Where a particular subclause of Part 1 is not mentioned in the Part 3-15, that subclause applies as far as
- relevant. When this document states "addition", "modification" or "replacement", the relevant text in Part 1 is to
- 34 be adapted accordingly.
