It also covers abnormal situations that can be expected in practice and takes into account the way in which electromagnetic phenomena can affect the safe operation of appliances.

## 5 General conditions for the tests

**5.2** *Add the following as a first sentence to Note 102:*

The test of 21.102 is carried out on a separate appliance.

## 7 Marking and instructions

**7.12** *Add the following dashed items:*

- the iron must be used and rested on a stable surface;
- when placing the iron on its stand, ensure that the surface on which the stand is placed is stable;
- the iron is not to be used if it has been dropped, if there are visible signs of damage or if it is leaking.
